

# Console Guidelines

*Please follow the guidelines below for all console use.*

- All consoles and games are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If you would like to be the next person to use a specific console or game, inform the Service Desk to be added to the waiting list.
- All requests for use of personal console gaming equipment must be approved by the Games Area Coordinator. The Games Area is not liable for any damage sustained to personal equipment used in this way.
- Only use Games Area accounts when logging into the consoles. Using personal accounts may result in the theft of personal information or loss of personal property. The Games Area is not liable for any harm that comes from logging into a personal account from these consoles. Any time spent deleting personal accounts will be charged to the owner of those accounts.
- Game Saves:
  - Do not delete save files from the consoles or the cloud services available to Games Area accounts.
  - Please give your save file a unique name so that you may find it again when you return.
  - The Games Area staff may need to delete game saves or content to free up space for more saves or content. We will do our best to only delete inactive files, or lacking that knowledge, the oldest files on the system.
- We will do our best to ensure that consoles and games all have the latest updates. However, if you should find that after checking out a console station and game, an update must be performed, please inform the Service Desk as soon as possible so that we do not charge you for the time spent updating the console.
- Though each console station may have a number of accessories and games associated with it, we will only give you material appropriate for the game you select to play. If you desire to play a different game, please inform the Service Desk and return all material associated with your previous game.
- Please inform the Service Desk as soon as possible if any console malfunction, equipment issue, or game error occurs.
- Please return all tables and chairs to their original position following the usage of any consoles.
